SoloForest Feature Files

The Solo Feature File is a list of available feature types to describe the GPS data you collect using SoloField or SoloForest. Some examples are Roads, Stands, Tract, Misc. Point,. Each has attributes associated which ask questions about the features. Here's an example using Roads; you might have attributes like Type, Width, Condition, and Name that prompt the user to input text or choose items from a pick list to populate and describe the feature. We have included some sample Feature Files for you to use and edit/customize for your application. To use these Feature Files simply:

- 1. Save the FEA file to your PC and then copy it over to the My Documents\Solo folder on your handheld device.
- 2. Open SoloField or SoloForest on the handheld and create a new project or open and existing one.
- 3. From the main map screen select the **File** menu and choose **Settings** and tap the Files tab. Tap Browse next to the Feature File field and select the new feature file. Ok out of the Settings and your new feature file will be loaded and ready to use.
